Arrival

Please arrive at 6:00pm entering through the stage door of the theater located in the back of the building.

Parking

Public parking is available in the back of the Theater, along Cherry Hill & Ridge Roads and at the Cherry Hill School across from the Theater on Ridge Road

Please report to the area designated for your performer marked by signs.

Pink BEAT  Dance Beat Tots ages 2 - 5

Green BEAT  Dance Beat Kidz ages 6 - 9

Blue BEAT  Dance Beat BOYZ

Purple BEAT  Dance Beat Tweens/Teens ages 10 – 18

Orange BEAT  Dance Beat Competitive Team

Each area will be staffed with appropriate supervision so enjoy the show!



Recital Fee

Each student involved in the show is subject to a \$50 recital fee due March 1, 2010. In exchange for the fee you will receive 2 tickets to each show, a Beat Line in the program (one line ad to congratulate your student) and a commemorative award. All students will perform in both shows.

Tickets

As mentioned above you will receive 2 tickets per show per student as part of your *Recital Fee*. Beyond that you will be able to purchase as many additional tickets as you like.

Ticket sales will begin April 24th at 10:00am at Dance Beat.

Belongings

Label everything! Check out the tear pages for recital hair & makeup. These pages include tips on how to style performers hair and apply stage make up.

Performers

All performers must stay back stage and are not permitted in the seating area of the theater. 2 – 5 year olds are permitted to leave at intermission but are encouraged to stay for the entire show!

Costume Changes

Students involved in only one dance should arrive and leave in that costume to reduce the number of people changing and lost items. Dressing Room Volunteers will be available to assist any students needing help. Most students are able to change on their own.

Volunteers

We would love your help with everything from spotlight and back stage assistance to dressing room monitors. We would like to limit the number of chaperones back stage to cut back on the crowding & confusion. Volunteers would only be assigned to one show so they are able to view the second show. Volunteers are able to sign up beginning April 24th at ticket sales. See Volunteer Positions.

Extras

You will receive a complimentary program at the show. You will be invited to participate in a 50/50 drawing to benefit the Dance Beat Competitive Team. You will have an opportunity to purchase a video of the show and you can choose which show you prefer to purchase.

Theater & House Rules

No food or drinks are permitted on stage.

Please remain seated in the house until house lights have come up.

Snacks and water are permitted in the dressing areas but must be cleaned up upon leaving.

Flash Photography & Video Taping

Is strictly prohibited and is disruptive to the performance. It is a house rule at the Village Theater that should either occur the show may be stopped until the device is removed. Please inform your guests.

Photographs may be taken during dress rehearsal.

Celebration Dinner

Dance Beat will be scheduling a studio dinner as part of our celebration. Please watch for details and pricing.

Awards Ceremony

An Awards ceremony will take place at the end of the Saturday 7pm show. Every student will be recognized for their achievement.

Volunteer Positions

Spotlight – Must be comfortable with heights and at least 18 years of age. Easy to learn & fun too!

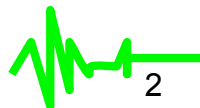
Stage Manager – 2 needed per show to wear headphones and manage back stage.

Stage Assistants – 2 needed per show to maintain order back stage and assist with props.

Line Up – 2 needed per show to bring next act in and take acts back to dressing room.

Hall Monitors – 2 needed per show to supervise the back hallway and keep performers quiet.

Dressing Room Chaperones – all must be female and over the age of 18



Chaperones need to keep order in the areas, provide assistance with costume changes if needed and assist with clean up.

Concessions – 2 needed per show before the show and at intermission to assist with concession sales

50/50 Raffle – 1 competition parent per show needed to sell tickets and run raffle.
